ORDER DISMISSING CASES WITH PREJUDICE

On December 12, 2007, the Court entered an Agreed Order Allowing Certain Late Claimants Limited Rights to Participate in the Plan's Settlement Facility. The Order provided that Settling Late Claimants are those "who affirmatively accept the terms of [the] Agreed Order or fail to timely reject the terms of the Agreed Order by filing with the Court a written notice of rejection no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this Agreed Order." (Dec. 12, 2007 Agreed Order, ¶ 12) Acceptance of the Agreed Order is "final and binding and may not be revoked and such case will be DISMISSED with prejudice." (Dec. 12, 2007 Agreed Order, ¶ 13)

An Eligible Late Claimant who wants to reject the settlement set forth in the Agreed Order must send a written notice to the Court, which must be received by the Court on or before thirty (30) days after the date of the Agreed Order. (Dec. 12, 2007 Agreed Order, ¶ 14) To date, only one Eligible Late Claimant, [REDACTED] has filed a written response to the parties' settlement offer set forth in the Agreed Order, which the Court will address in a separate order.

Accordingly,

The remaining Eligible Late Claimants, whose names and case numbers are attached to this Order, are considered Settling Late Claimants and the cases are DISMISSED with prejudice.
