**PROPOSED ORDER
GRANTING DOW CORNING CORPORATION'S AND
THE DEBTOR'S REPRESENTATIVES' MOTION TO
STAY THE COURT'S RULING GRANTING THE FINANCE
COMMITTEE'S MOTION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO MAKE
SECOND PRIORITY PAYMENTS PENDING APPEAL**

The Court has considered Dow Corning Corporation's and the Debtor's Representatives' Motion to Stay the Court's Ruling Granting the Finance Committee's Motion for Authorization to Make Second Priority Payments Pending Appeal ("Motion to Stay") and their Memorandum in Support of the Motion to Stay, and the Court finds and concludes that the Motion to Stay is meritorious and the relief sought should be granted.
