Dear Ms. Dovolis:

We have received your letter and acknowledge your representation of the Dow Corning is concerned about the well-being of patients who use our products and we are willing to work with you to attempt to resolve this matter.

The claims process is initiated through this office. As a starting point, we will need to obtain medical records. To that end, enclosed are two copies of an Authorization to Release Medical Information. Please have the sign and date both copies and return them to me along with the names and addresses of all physicians who have treated the process.

In addition, we will need to obtain the removed, sterilized implants for examination by our laboratory. Our company policy with regard to claims is based upon this examination. Should the state of difficulties prove to be related to our materials or our workmanship, we will assume financial responsibility for the reasonable, uninsured, out-of-pocket expenses associated with her corrective surgery. We would also be willing to consider a claim for general damages.
