ANAPLASTIC LARGE CELL LYMPHOMA CAUSED BY BREAST IMPLANTS

"Anaplastic large cell lymphoma caused by breast implants in humans" refers to a rare type of cancer called "Breast Implant-Associated Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma (BIA-ALCL)", which is a non-Hodgkin's lymphoma that develops in the scar tissue surrounding a breast implant, most commonly associated with textured implants; it is considered a cancer of the immune system, not the breast tissue itself.

Breast implant-associated anaplastic large cell lymphoma is also called BIA-ALCL. It's a rare form of lymphoma that occurs in some people who've had breast implants. It's a type of immune system cancer and isn't breast cancer.

Breast Implant-Associated Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma (BIA-ALCL)

BIA-ALCL is a type of cancer caused by textured breast implants. Early detection is important. Complete surgical removal of the implant and the surrounding capsule can cure BIA-ALCL. If the cancer spreads, you may need radiation therapy or chemotherapy.

Breast Implant-Associated Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma (BIA-ALCL)

BIA-ALCL is a type of lymphoma that can develop around breast implants. BIA-ALCL occurs most frequently in patients who have breast implants with textured surfaces. This is a cancer of the immune system, not a type of breast cancer. The current lifetime risk of BIA-ALCL is estimated to be 1:2,207-1:86,029 for women with textured implants based upon current confirmed cases and textured implant sales data over the past two decades.
