**Response By Kevin McLean To Order To Show Cause**


Dear Judge Hood:

At the risk of conducting motion practice by letter, I am compelled to respond to the March 24, 2008 letter sent to you by Kevin McLean, the Respondent in the above-captioned matter.

In his letter, Mr. McLean states that he is sending no further response because he is aware of only three clients who have complained of his conduct. Your Honor's February 5, 2008 Order could not have been more specific. It required Mr. McLean to "... provide a full accounting of all settlement checks that have been sent to him, including all claimants ..." listed in Exhibit A to the Order. Specifically, the response required by the Order was not limited to Mr. McLean's clients who have complained about Mr. McLean's conduct whether or not Mr. McLean is aware of such complaints. The Order required an accounting with respect to **all** clients listed in Exhibit A. If, as Mr. McLean contends, he is concerned with Attorney-Client privilege issues, I have no objection if a full accounting of the clients listed in Exhibit A is filed under seal.
