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Mrs. [REDACTED] is a patient who has recently come under my care in the last few months. Mrs. [REDACTED] was diagnosed with atypical connective tissue disease by Dr. Maurice McCarthy in Winter Haven, Florida initially apparently in 1994. I have a follow up letter from Dr. McCarthy dated June 12, 2002 that has patient being 100% disabled due to her polyarthropathy and polyarthritis which is related to the atypical connective disease. Mrs. [REDACTED] describes chronic pain associated with the disease and pain in her joints at various time. Currently Mrs. [REDACTED] is 100% disabled. Due the pain associated with her arthralgias, Mrs. [REDACTED] is unable to work. Previously Mrs. [REDACTED] apparently was employed as a secretary but due to the underlying arthralgias is unable to perform that job or any other job at this time due to her pain. In addition, Mrs. [REDACTED] reports that she's unable to maintain her activities of daily living at home due to pain. Her husband reports that he has to assist her with feeding, grooming as well as dressing due to her pain symptoms. Her diagnosis is atypical connective tissue disease again was made by her rheumatologist, Dr. Maurice McCarthy, Jr. in Winter Haven, Florida.




