Attached is a spreadsheet with three tabs. Tab 1 lists the claimants on the spreadsheet Ed sent on Friday except for (a) the one duplicate claim; (b) the fourteen claimants who are on payment hold (and thus not ripe for payment) that you will find listed on Tab 2; (c) the five claimants who have been paid (listed on Tab 3); (d) the two claimants who are not ripe for a disease payment (also on Tab 3); (e) one claimant who was paid an SF-DCT award before the establishment of the Lien Procedures (also on Tab 3); and (f) the one claimant whose lien you have withdrawn (also on Tab 3). Finally, Tab 1 contains one claimant, Carolyn Pugh (second from the end on the list) who we was inadvertently omitted from the prior list.

Tab 1 contains the names and addresses we have for the attorneys of record for the represented claimants and where there is no attorney, the address of the claimant. It is my understanding that these 43 claimants are the only ones who will be served with the MDL Motion and Brief with respect to this matter.

As to the fourteen claimants listed on Tab 2, we are continuing to review the files and I hope that in the near future we will determine how we want to proceed with respect to these claimants. In the event we determine these claimants have an allowable claim, and assuming there has not been a judicial determination as to how we should proceed, I will notify you as to these claimants' status

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
