Dear Claimants and Attorneys,

On June 18, 2007, Judge Denise Page Hood entered an Order regarding lien claims filed by the MDL 926 Claims Office against certain claimants who have claims ready for payment in the Settlement Facility - Dow Corning Trust (SFDCT). (A copy of the Order is available to read or download on the CAC website - www.tortcomm.org - under "Court Orders.") We are informed by the Settlement Facility that you either are or represent one of the claimants affected by this Order, and therefore, you are being sent a copy of this letter. Please read this letter carefully because it contains information and deadlines about your or your client's claim and right to payment.

The Order provides that the MDL 926 Claims Office must file a motion with the District Court on or before June 29, 2007. A copy of their motion is being provided to you with this mailing. The CAC has agreed to coordinate a response of the claimants against whom the lien claim was filed, or you may instead choose to file a response on your own. **The Response is due August 1, 2007.** The Order provides that the motion is only on the *common threshold issues of whether the MDL 926 Claims Office has standing or any legal basis to assert a lien against certain claimants* including you. The Order does not provide for the MDL 926 Claims Office to get into any details about your individual claim submission at this stage; indeed, there are orders that protect your right to confidentiality. Rather, the Order sets up a briefing schedule on a common legal issue.
