**FINANCE COMMITTEE’S MOTION TO VACATE OR DISMISS ORDER
TO SHOW CAUSE WITH RESPECT TO PETER TANGREDI**

The Finance Committee respectfully requests that the Court vacate or dismiss the Order to Show Cause requiring Peter Tangredi to appear before the Court on May 9, 2019, to show cause why he should not be sanctioned, held in contempt and otherwise required to respond because of his law office’s conduct with respect to \$2,500 in claim payment funds. (Doc. #1493). In support of this motion, the Finance Committee would show the Court as follows:

1. On May 7, 2019, Mr. Tangredi provided an affidavit to counsel for the Finance Committee that he has recently located the claimant, who has married and changed her name, and he will be disbursing the funds within the next coming days. See Exhibit A.

2. Accordingly, the Finance Committee no longer seeks sanctions against Mr. Tangredi and it is no longer necessary or equitable to proceed with a show cause hearing. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b)(6) (“On a motion and upon such
