**ORDER NO. 6**

Before the court is an objection by Baxter Healthcare Corporation to the production, absent a protective order under Rule 26(c), of certain documents requested by the plaintiffs. Upon consideration after a telephone conference call with the parties, the court orders as follows:

1. Baxter is directed to produce its documents relating to research and development and manufacturing, and its request for a protective order regarding this production is denied.
2. Baxter is directed to produce documents reporting adverse reactions or other product complaints; provided, however, that, with respect to documents naming or otherwise identifying the recipient of an implant, the names of the patient and of the physician or health care provider shall be kept confidential (and disclosed only to the extent needed by litigants in this litigation) unless that confidentiality is waived by the patient (or, if the patient is a named plaintiff, by the attorney for that person).
